We believe in the physical resurrection of Christ.


We believe in the personal return of Christ.

We are a group of volunteers whose lives have been changed by the power of the love of God and His Word. We desire to bring His message of love and hope to those incarcerated in prisons, the recovery community and wherever God leads us. Our Director has been active in prison ministry since 1999 and is now helping to lead a team of visionaries standing in the power of God. Through our commitments in this ministry, we are experiencing new found faith, new decisions, and re-commitments to Jesus Christ.



**Our Mission Statement:** is to present the gospel to people incarcerated in prison systems and abroad: to lead them to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ; to bring hope in what seems to be a hopeless situation; to disciple them through the teaching of God's Word and to prepare them for living a Godly lifestyle.

## Areas of Ministry:

We meet on a weekly basis for worship and the preaching and teaching of God's word in prisons and churches. On occasion, we will have special musical guests. We have one-on-one discipleship as needed and available. We are currently leading a new addictions program "The Road To Recovery" on Friday evenings at Christian Life Center, Bensalem PA. And the New Conquering Grounds Café, a free coffee house with live entertainment, in The Edge Building at Christian Life Center one Saturday a month.
